

Traffic Management During Normal School Days

To ensure the safety of our Outramians, we would like to appeal to parents/guardians who are driving their children/wards to school to abide by the vehicular movement arrangements of the school. In view that there is possible traffic congestion, parents/guardians are encouraged to drop their children/ward off early to avoid jams or delays.

The peak hours are as follows:

Before the start of school:

- 6.30 am – 7.00 am: Peak Hour
- 7.00 am – 7.30 am: Super Peak Hour

School Dismissal

- 3.00 pm – 4.00 pm: Peak Hour

Section 1: At York Hill Campus

1.1 Before the start of school

- (a) There is strictly no parking or waiting in the school compound parents/ guardians dropping off their children/wards.
- (b) All vehicles are to enter the school through the back gate before 7.30 am. In the event of wet weather, vehicles may enter the school via the front gate for dropping off.
- (c) After 7.30 am, vehicles are not allowed into the school compound for safety reasons. Parents/guardians may drop their children/wards off at the public carpark opposite the front gate (Block 13, York Hill HDB open-air carpark) and Outramians may then use the zebra crossing to enter the school via turnstile gate on foot.

1.2 School Dismissal: varies according to students' timetable

- (a) There is strictly no parking or waiting in the school compound for parents/guardians picking up their children/wards.
- (b) All vehicles are to enter the school through the front gate to pick their children/wards up after school dismissal.
- (c) Parents/guardians may also wait at the public carpark opposite the front gate (Block 13, York Hill HDB open-air carpark) to pick their children/wards up after school dismissal.
- (d) Avoid stopping along York Hill and nearby roads to drop off or pick up passengers, as this may create bottlenecks and safety risks. Please use only the designated drop off points within school direction.

(d) After entering the school via the Anchorvale Crescent Gate 2 (opposite Bellewaters Condo), parents/guardians will take the following route to drop off their child/ward (please refer to **Picture C** below):

- Proceed straight to Drop Off Area 1 and exit by turning left only via the Anchorvale Crescent Gate 3 (please refer to **Picture D** below).

- (e) Parents/guardians may drop their children/wards off at nearby HDB blocks/carparks, and students may then use the traffic light crossing and/or walkways along Anchorvale Crescent to enter school via the pedestrian gate (**Picture B**).
- (f) Outramians can also enter school on foot via the Anchorvale Street pedestrian Gate 5 (please refer to **Picture E** below).

2.2 School Dismissal: varies according to students' timetable

- (a) Parents/guardians are not allowed to drive into the school to pick up their children/wards after school dismissal except wet weather. They may wait at the nearby HDB blocks/carparks to pick them up.
- (b) Avoid stopping along the roads around the school (i.e. Anchorvale Street and Anchorvale Crescent) to drop off or pick up passengers, as this contributes to bottlenecks.

Please be reminded to strictly observe transport safety rules and procedures within the school compound. We would also like to appeal to all parents/guardians to co-operate with our staff and security officers to enhance traffic safety in and around our school.

Traffic Management During School Events


To help ensure smooth traffic flow during school events such as Parents Engagement Day, Speech Day, Graduation Ceremony, Award Ceremony and Open House, etc, we kindly seek support from parents/guardians on the following:

Section 1: At York Hill Campus

- (a) Choose public transport whenever possible, as the York Hill Campus is easily accessible via Outram Park MRT Station, followed by a short walk, or by buses that stop along Havelock Road or Outram Road.
- (b) If you are driving, please park only at the designated nearby carparks, namely the Block 13, York Hill HDB open-air carpark or the HDB Multi Storey Carpark (MSCP) at Block 8A Jalan Kukoh, to avoid congestion around the campus.

Section 2: At Anchorvale Campus

- (a) Choose public transport whenever possible, as the campus is conveniently served by nearby bus stops along Anchorvale Street and Anchorvale Crescent, as well as Farmway LRT.
- (b) If you are driving, please consider alternative parking options at the neighbouring MSCPs at Blk 338 and Blk 329, in addition to Blk 334 MSCP near to the campus (please refer to **Picture F** below).
