



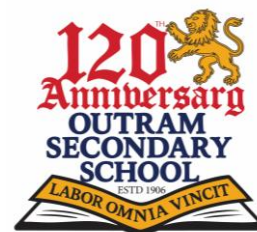

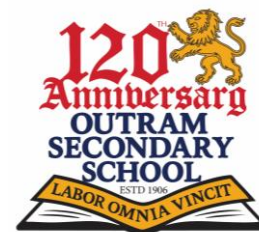
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1. Student Development Theme in Term 4 – Labor Omnia Vincit

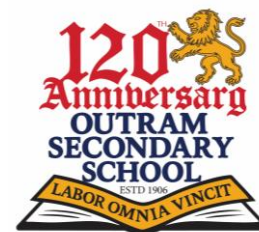

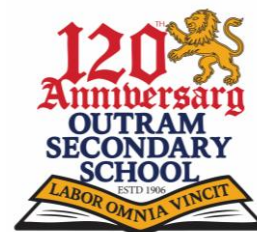
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3. School's Newsletter on Term 3 Activities

5. Academic and Assessment Matters for Secondary 1 and 3

As we prepare your child/ward for the upcoming year-end school examinations, we appreciate your close partnership in monitoring your child/ward's revision schedule, and in supporting, encouraging and affirming your child/ward's efforts.

The End-of-Year Examinations for Secondary 1 and Secondary 3 Outramians will be conducted from **23 September to 9 October 2026**. Please refer to the specific examination timetables for the respective academic levels/streams, sent to parents via Parents Gateway in Term 3.

6. Marking Day and Promotion Day

Marking Day and Promotion Day are scheduled on **12 October 2026, Monday** and **16 October 2026, Friday** respectively. Outramians are not required to attend school on these two days.





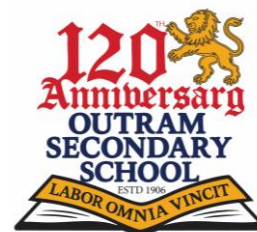
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7. Post-Examination Programme for Secondary 1 and 3

The Post-Examination Programme for Secondary 1 and 3 will take place **from 13 October 2026, Tuesday to 22 October 2026, Thursday**. Additional details will be provided by the respective Key Personnel later. The post-examination dismissal time is 1.00 pm, unless otherwise communicated.

8. Meet-the-Parents Session (MPS) in Term 4 for Sec 1 and Sec 3 Levels

Outramians are not required to attend school on **23 October 2026, Friday**, which is set aside for the Term 4 MPS for Secondary 1 and 3 students. Parents/guardians may book an MPS slot in Parents Gateway (PG) to meet the Form Teachers (FTs). For parents/guardians who are not available for the MPS that day, they may book a slot on another date between **22 October 2026, Thursday to 6 November 2026, Friday** in Parents Gateway (PG) to meet the FTs.

The duration of Term 4 MPS allows more time for parents/guardians to arrange a meeting or conversation with their child/ward's FTs and Subject Teachers for the purpose of providing feedback and suggestions for his/her areas for growth. The MPS helps to strengthen the school's partnership with parents/guardians to help Outramians succeed in their educational journey. More information will be disseminated to parents/guardians in Term 4.

9. Continuing Our CCA Days Arrangement in 2027

In 2027, we will continue with **Wednesdays and odd-week Fridays as CCA Days** for students from both Anchorvale and York Hill Campuses. For the graduating level Outramians from the York Hill Campus, we will continue to provide **two-way transportation to and from the Anchorvale Campus** on these days in Semester 1,





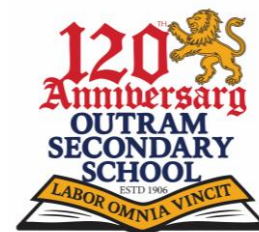
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where CCAs will stand down for them at the end of Term 2. This arrangement enables Outramians from both campuses to come together regularly for joint CCA sessions and activities. Having implemented this arrangement over the past year, we have seen several benefits, and we will continue it for **one final year** in 2027:

- **More opportunities for student leadership** – Outramians have greater opportunities to take on leadership roles by guiding peers and juniors, organising activities, representing their CCAs, and contributing to the growth of their teams. These experiences help them develop greater confidence and a stronger sense of responsibility.
- **Reinforced school identity and pride** – Regular joint CCA sessions strengthen Outramians' sense of belonging to the wider Outramian family, extending beyond their individual campuses.
- **Stronger collaboration and bonding across campuses** – Coming together regularly nurtures friendship, strengthens team spirit, and reinforces our shared Outramian identity.
- **A richer and more engaging learning environment** – With a larger combined student group, CCA sessions benefit from more diverse interactions, deeper peer learning, and greater opportunities for participation.
- **Fair and consistent access for all students** – Common CCA Days provide all Outramians, regardless of campus, with equal opportunities to access facilities and training resources across both campuses. This is especially valuable with the **new facilities at the Anchorvale Campus**, which can support training and coaching in preparation for competitions and events.





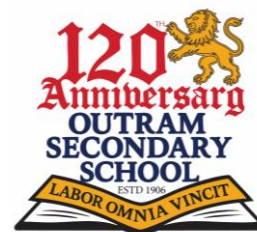
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- **Optimised use of resources and coaching support** – Bringing Outramians together allows coaches and teachers to plan more effectively, focus on quality training, and make full use of the facilities available across both campuses.
- **Better support for students' school-life balance** – By scheduling CCAs on Wednesdays and odd-week Fridays each fortnight, we provide Outramians with advance clarity on their CCA commitments. This allows students to better manage their academic and personal commitments on other school days, while encouraging greater ownership of their well-being.

We are confident that this **structured and inclusive approach** will continue to provide a richer, more meaningful and fulfilling CCA experience for all Outramians, while strengthening the connections and shared identity that help unite our two campuses.

10. 120th Anniversary Celebration and Anchorvale Campus Opening Ceremony

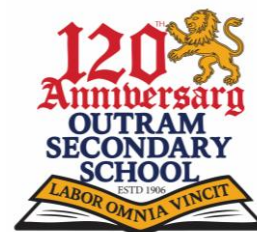
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11. School Open House at the Anchorvale Campus

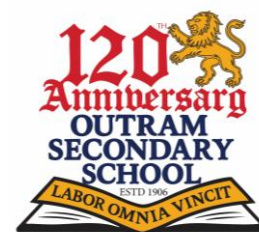
